Some of our surgical offerings include endoscopic brow lift/forehead surgery, face lift, liposuction, chin augmentation, eyelid surgery, ear surgery, scar revision and nasal plastic surgery.

For individuals interested in achieving a more youthful appearance without the inconvenience of surgery, we offer several options of skin fillers such as Restylane, Juvederm, Perlane, Radiesse and Belotero which soften lines and contours for a more youthful appearance. We also offer Botulinum injections such as Botox, Dysport and Xeomin to treat heavy frown lines and "crows feet" to create a more relaxed look.

Additional non-surgical therapy options include skin rejuvenation treatments such as intense pulsed light, or fraxel, that provide safe and effective treatment for sun damage, melasma, stretch marks, mild to moderate scarring, fine lines, skin texture and rosacea.

OUR CARE

offers attentive, personalized care to make your experience with us as comfortable as possible, from managing your appointments to coordinating with the surgical facility through your recovery period.

Making Appointments. The first step is scheduling a consultation with one of our physicians. While an appointment with one of our assistants is complimentary, a surgical consultation with a surgeon requires a nominal \$100 fee that can be applied towards future surgery or any of our other services. All consultations are private, thorough and educational. When scheduling, our patient coordinator can help you determine the appropriate staff member. You can schedule your appointment by calling 703.383.7340 weekdays from 9am to 5pm. Because we take our time with each individual caller without interruption, you may be asked to leave a message and your phone call will be returned promptly. If you need to cancel your appointment, please provide 24 hours notice to avoid a cancellation fee.

Your Visit. Prior to examination, photos may be taken for computer imaging purposes as well as documentation of the treatment process. A medical assistant or nurse will escort you to the exam room where you will be asked questions about your past medical history and details about your concerns. Our physician will then examine you, request and/or perform diagnostic tests if necessary and recommend a treatment plan to address your concerns. You may be asked to schedule a return visit for follow-up. If surgery is recommended and elected, our staff will assist you in collecting the necessary pre-surgical information and tests, and go over post-operative recovery and care.

Telephone Calls. We are always available to discuss concerns with our patients. Our staff has been trained to answer most questions, but if there are additional inquiries, your chart will be given to your doctor and his or her answer will be relayed to you. Calls from the doctors themselves are usually made after office hours.

After Hours. Our physicians are available during nights and weekends for emergency calls only. Please contact our office at 703.383.8130 and follow the prompts for paging the physician on call.

OUR FEES

Payment for all office procedures is expected at the time of service. If surgery is performed, you will be charged a fee by our physician as well as by the surgical center or hospital and any other assisting physician. Many of our surgical fees include a specified period of post-operative care directly related to the surgery but do not cover unrelated conditions that may arise.

Fees for purely elective procedures such as facial plastic surgery are paid in advance of the surgery.
